

Important Update

In response to the COVID-19 emergency declaration, the Landmarks Preservation Commission will temporarily close its office at 1 Centre Street, but will continue to provide services by email and phone. For the past week, LPC has been working hard to adjust its processes and procedures to ensure we can continue to serve the city while protecting the health of its employees and the general public. This message outlines measures we are taking to create social distancing and help reduce the spread of the virus.

- We have canceled all public hearings for the remainder of March. Though future hearings will still be scheduled, they are subject to change, so please check our website for any updates. We may be canceling future hearings or making alternative arrangements as needed.
- All staff is working remotely at this time and checking emails and voicemails on a regular basis.
- LPC is temporarily accepting electronic filing of all permit applications and is issuing permits electronically. Application forms and associated drawings, photographs and other materials must be emailed to LPC at applications@lpc.nyc.gov.
